## Demographics

Advanced Ed. students have some significantly different demographic features compared to the Folsom Lake College overall student body: Advanced Ed. students are somewhat more likely to female (57\% vs. $54 \%$ ), somewhat more likely to be White ( $64 \%$ vs. $57 \%$ ), much more likely to be Middle Income or above ( $58 \%$ vs. $44 \%$ ), and much less likely to be first generation college students ( $6 \% \mathrm{vs} .23 \%$ ).

## Student Success

Advanced Education students are significantly more likely to remain enrolled in a course throughout the semester (retention rate) than the overall FLC student body (average of $96 \%$ vs. $85 \%$ ). Advanced Ed. students are also much more likely than the average FLC student to successfully complete their course with a passing grade (avg. $94 \%$ vs. $73 \%$ ).



## Feeder High Schools

The majority of Advanced Ed students come from our local feeder schools: Folsom High, Oak Ridge High, Ponderosa High, and Vista del Lago High. A significant number of Advanced Ed students also come from home school settings and other California high schools.
