

Research Brief: Enrollments from Local Feeder High Schools

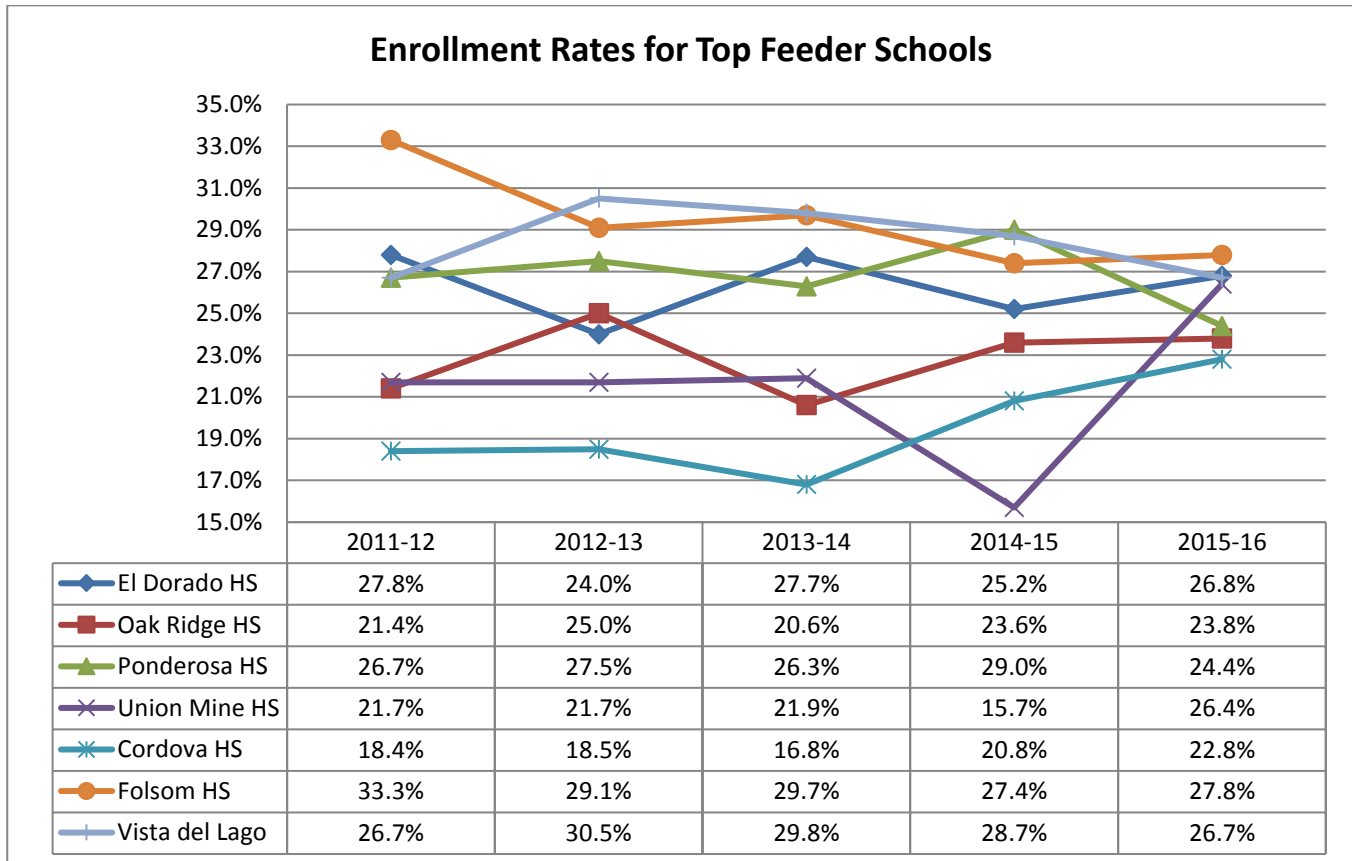
Number of HS Grads Transitioning to FLC

Over the past 5 year reporting period, the number of students graduating from local feeder high schools has remained relatively stable. The majority of new, first time students come high schools in the El Dorado Union Mine School District (El Dorado, Oak Ridge, Ponderosa, & Union Mine) and the Folsom Cordova Unified School District (Cordova, Folsom & Vista del Lago).

Enrollment Rates of Top Feeder Schools

The enrollment rate is the percentage of the high school's graduating class that transitioned in the fall of that same year to Folsom Lake College. On average, 25% of the graduating classes from these top feeder schools transition to Folsom Lake College.¹



¹ **Data Source:** Class size data by high school from California Department of Education, DataQuest. (Note: that data on class size is released by CDE in April of year following graduation of the HS cohort). Data on number of students who transitioned from a local feeder HS to FLC is taken from the *CCC Apply* application. It should be noted that the application provides a drop down menu of public high schools for the entire state. That list is cumbersome to navigate, there are many schools with similar names, and not all small or new high schools are included in the menu. Data should be interpreted with caution.
