

## Research Brief: Enrollments from Local Feeder High Schools

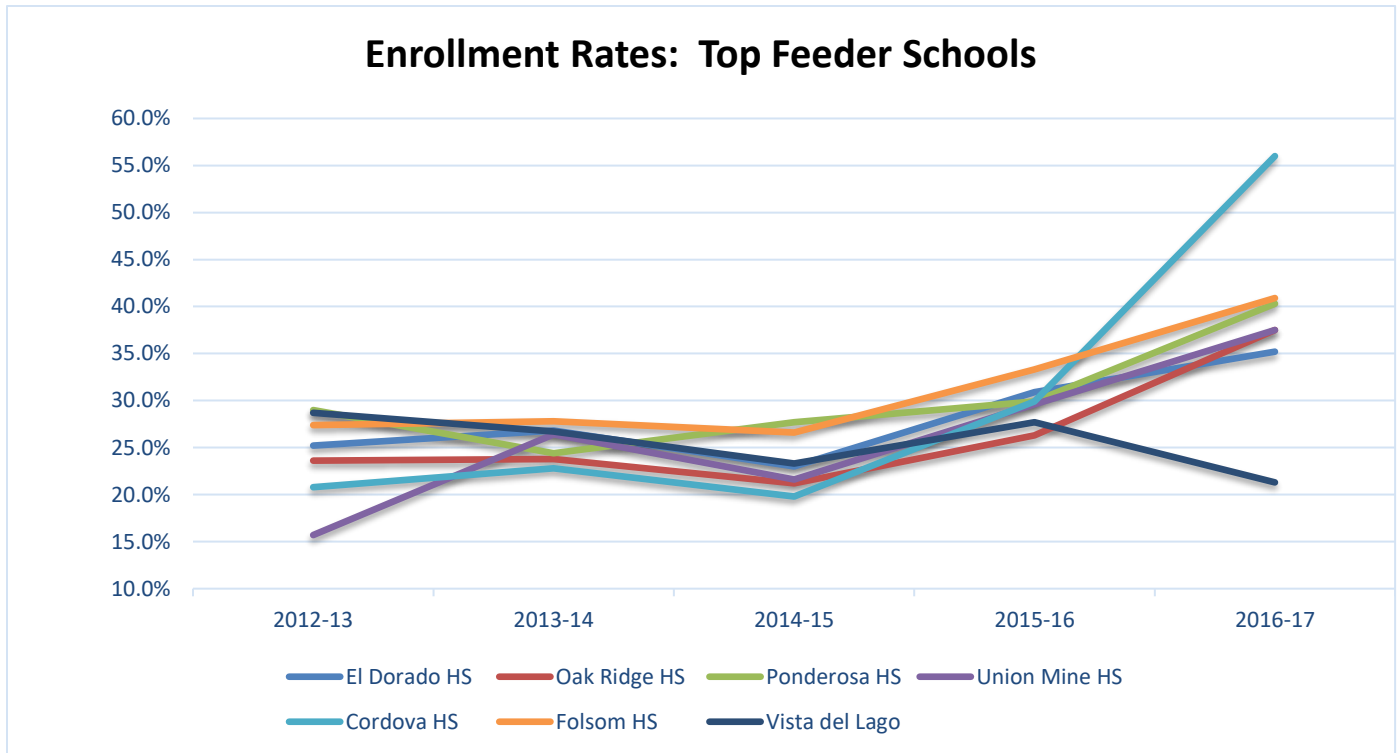
### Number of HS Grads Transitioning to FLC

Over the past 5 year reporting period, the number of students graduating from local feeder high schools has remained relatively stable, but number of students transitioning to FLC has been steadily increasing (up 7% this year). The majority of new, first time students come from high schools in the El Dorado Union Mine School District (El Dorado, Oak Ridge, Ponderosa, & Union Mine) and the Folsom Cordova Unified School District (Cordova, Folsom & Vista del Lago).

## Enrollment Rates of Top Feeder Schools

The enrollment rate is the percentage of the high school's graduating class that transitioned in the fall of that same year to Folsom Lake College. On average, 30% of the graduating classes of 2015-2016 from these top feeder schools transition to Folsom Lake College.<sup>i</sup> In the most current cohort (2016-17), the enrollment rates for these top feeder school rose dramatically to 38%.

<sup>i</sup> **Data Sources:** Class size data by high school is taken from California Department of Education, DataQuest; class size is released by CDE in April of year following graduation of the HS cohort. Data on number of students who transitioned from a local feeder HS to FLC is taken from the CCC Apply application, LRCCD Data Warehouse. It should be noted that CCC Apply provides a very large drop down menu of public high schools for the entire state. That list is cumbersome to navigate, there are many schools with similar names, and not all small or new high schools are included in the menu. Data should be interpreted with caution.
