- The front wheels extend in front of the cabin space which provides for a smoother ride and better handling capabilities.
- The 72volt batteries will provide the extra "kick" needed to navigate the hills that are around the EDC campus.
- The larger batteries will all allow for longer use times between charges.
- The Polaris only requires a 110 outlet for charging.
- The 12 inch tires are easier to replace and provide for better stability and handling by drivers.
- The longer wheel base also will help with handling of the vehicle around the campus.
- The ladder rack and fold down stake back/it adds to the GEM's functionality.
- Pricing is only \$270 more than the Taylor Dunn model.




