Reception Immediately Following Ceremony

Explanation of Rituals and Symbols

Call to Order

Drumming will be used as an instrument to communicate that the Ceremony is about to begin. It also sends a signal to all participants (honorees and guests) the transitional moment of focusing our collective attention and energy on the event about to take place. Through these deeds, we create a sacred space to express our greatest intentions so that what we do can be for the greatest good.

Permission from Elders/Eldership

In many African societies, 'Elders' are the custodians of the village, community or land. Because of this caretaking and oversight role, it is appropriate that we ask their blessings for any event, activity or plans involving that community/village. This is also done as a sign of respect, and in recognition of the experience and knowledge of the elders of our community.

Okyeame

"Okyeame" is an Akan word which represents a spokesperson, ambassador, and interpreter to a village (community) elder or chief.

Pouring of Libation

The African tradition of pouring Libation at all important social gatherings is another way to communicate with God and to honor and remember our ancestors. Libation recognizes those members of our family and larger community that lived in the past and laid the foundation for those of us still living.

Transition Ritual

We are gathered here to honor our students and symbolically mark their transition in the educational arena. This transition ceremony is also a way to communicate those values, intentions and behaviors important to the continued facilitation of growth and development toward fulfillment of future goals. The conferring of kente cloth strips and the Stool Ceremony will serve as the symbols in this Transition Ritual.

- **Kente Cloth**

The Kente cloth originates from the Asante Kingdom of Ghana. Kente is an Asante ceremonial cloth that comes in various colors, sizes, and design and are worn during very important social and religious occasions. In a cultural context, kente is more important than just a cloth. It is a visual representation of history, philosophy, ethics, oral literature, moral values, and social code of conduct, religious beliefs, political thought and aesthetic principles. Conferring the kente cloth symbolizes our historical and cultural tradition of continuing to strive for excellence and achievement. The Kente students receive is meant to remind them of their accomplishments and reinforce their responsibility to continue that which is good.

- **Stool Ceremony**

According to tradition, the Golden Stool which is made of pure gold, flew out of the sky and landed on the lap of the first king of the Asante's, Nana Osei-Tutu. The nation prospered and flourished and became famous for gold and brass, and the famous brightly colored hand-woven 'kente' cloth which is widely recognized as an African symbol. The Golden Stool is considered to be so sacred that no one is allowed to sit on it. It is kept under the strictest security and is taken outside only on exceptional occasions and never comes into contact with the ground. The Stool has become a symbol of the unifying force of the Asante people and it is believed to contain the soul or sunsum of the Asante nation. Replicas of the Golden Stool are hand carved out of wood and used in the enstoolment ceremonies of chiefs, kings, and queen mothers. The Asante Stools are also used in religious, transitional and/or rite of passage ceremonies.
