**Did you know CSEC happens in El Dorado County? Did you know that  
foster care is a pipeline for the Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children?**

**Human trafficking** is a \$32 billion dollar global industry, involving over 100,000 children in the United States. After drug trafficking and counterfeiting, it is the world's most profitable criminal activity. It is estimated that an exploiter may earn as much as \$650,000 in a year by exploiting as few as four children.

This new training is specifically designed for foster parents, relative caregivers, and group home staff as a first step in combatting the Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children in California. We are working to raise awareness of the crisis at hand and increasing your ability to identify commercially sexually exploited children.

**You will leave with:**

- **Awareness** about what is happening in our state to our children and where this is happening;
- **Understanding** about why are our children in foster care so vulnerable and how they can be influenced by a trafficker;
- **Identification of the warning signs**; the ability to spot red flags that indicate a child is being sexually exploited.
- **Information on local efforts** regarding prevention and intervention

**Our speaker, Josephine Feemster**, is an adult survivor of Commercial Sexual Exploitation.
