- 4. INVOICES: Invoices shall be prepared and submitted in duplicate unless otherwise specified. - 21. 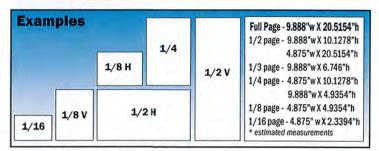

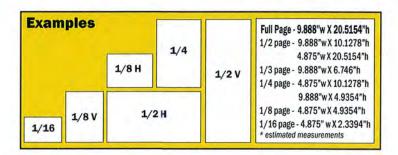
