



About Us

The Community Observatory opened in 2006 and, with an all-volunteer staff of docents, provides free viewing through our many telescopes, including our 17-inch and 14-inch reflecting telescopes.

The Community Observatory was a Rotary Club of Cameron Park Centennial Project in recognition of the 100th anniversary of Rotary International. The Rotary Club of Cameron Park members raised all of the funds and donated time and materials to build the observatory on land owned by the El Dorado County Office of Education adjacent to the El Dorado Center of Folsom Lake College.

In 2011, Rotary Club of Cameron Park built the G. Arthur Cort Sky Theater where visitors can sit in reclined seating outside and view the constellations or enjoy a sky tour by one of our docents.

In addition to nighttime viewing, the Community Observatory provides free, safe solar viewing on the first Saturday of every month. We also provide safe solar viewing to many schools, clubs, and organizations.



Preparing for Your Visit

The winter months are some of the best months for Observatory activities. However, it will almost always be cold and

Solar Saturdays

On the first Saturday of every month, visit the observatory for safe viewing of our Sun. We will show you the sun through our solar telescopes fitted with white-light and Hydrogen-Alpha filters to view the sun in a safe manner. Our visitors have seen Sunspots, Prominences, and the occasional solar flare.
